Ruby Sahota Official Sworn In as the Re-Elected Member of Parliament

25/11/2019 – Brampton, ON – Ms. Ruby Sahota, the re-elected Member of Parliament for Brampton North, was joined by family, friends, volunteers, and supporters as she reaffirmed the Oath of Office to be sworn in, once again, as the Member of Parliament for Brampton North.
