NEW AND EXPANDED FEDERAL **COVID-19 SUPPORTS**

New! Canada Worker Lockdown Benefit

Eligible Canadians can receive \$300 per week when their earnings drop 50% or have become unemployed due to a local lockdown.

Applications for Ontario workers are now open.

Expanded! Employment Insurance

Our new, temporary El program has been expanded to be more flexible, simpler, and accessible to more workers. With these changes, our El program is helping more Canadians, quicker.

xpanded! Canada Worker Benefit

This refundable tax credit helps Canadians who are working and earning a low income.

We've expanded eligibility by making the benefit available to those with incomes up to \$32,244 for single Canadians, \$42,197 for single -earner families, and \$56,197 for double-earner families.

Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit

Workers can earn \$500 per week if they are unable to work at least 50% of the week due to getting COVID-19 or are self-isolating due to COVID-19, or have specific medical conditions.

Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit

Provides \$500 a week for those who must care for a child under 12 or family members because schools or care facilities are closed due to COVID-19 or because the child or family member is sick and/or required to quarantine

MP Sahota's Economic Update



Thanks to the hard work of Canadians, we've surpassed our goal of **1 million jobs**, bringing us back to pre-pandemic job levels. Last December, Canada's job market created over **55,000 jobs**, which brought Canada's unemployment down to **5.9%-** the lowest it's been since the start of the pandemic! Canada **has recovered 106% of jobs** lost compared to only 80% in the USA.

In more good news, **Canada's GDP has increased by 5.4%**, which is far beyond the initial growth forecast and well ahead of our allies including Japan, the UK, and Australia. Canada remains well below similar countries when it comes to inflation, with the USA experiencing 6.2% inflation, Germany having 6% and Canada coming in well below at **4.7%**.

As our government continues to invest in the economy, we know that we will continue to strengthen Canada's economic situation. **Together, we can keep Canada's economy moving forward– for everyone.**

Ontario's current restrictions to curb the spread of COVID-19 are set to be reassessed on January 26, 2022.
