## **Brampton MPs Hold Joint Canada Post Consultations**

MP Ruby Sahota participates in Joint Canada Post Consultations

18/08/2016 – Brampton, Ontario – The five Brampton MPs – Ruby Sahota (Brampton North), Raj Grewal (Brampton East), Kamal Khara (Brampton West), Sonia Sidhu (Brampton South) and Ramesh Sangha (Brampton Centre) held a town hall discussion as part of the Government of Canada’s public consultations to ensure Canadians receive quality postal service at a reasonable price.

This consultation supports a thorough and informed public discussion permitting Canadians from coast to coast to coast have a direct say in service they value and need from Canada Post. This joint Brampton town hall focused on openness and transparency, getting the facts, and considering the needs of Canadians.
