Brampton North Youth Council Meets with Minister Chagger

25/02/2020 – Brampton, ON – Ms. Ruby Sahota, the re-elected Member of Parliament for Brampton North, welcomed the Honourable Bardish Chagger, Minister of Diversity and Inclusion and Youth to Brampton to meet with the 2020 Brampton North Youth Council on Friday, February 21st 2020.

The 2020 Brampton North Youth Council is a group of dynamic individuals aged 13 to 26 years old who are interested in learning more about Canada's political process, sharing their viewpoints on issues impacting youth, and most importantly, get involved in their community.

“Each year I host a youth council because I believe giving youth a voice is vital to having a strong and effective government. The youth perspective brings a new light to issues impacting our community, and our country,” said MP Sahota. “A big part of giving youth a voice is empowering them by demonstrating how accessible their elected representatives are and how Ministers like Bardish truly care about what they have to say.”

Minister Chagger spoke with the Youth Council for over an hour, discussing current news, how intersectionality is important to policy making, the benefits of reducing the voting age, and how the Council can amplify their voice and enact change. The Minister's visit concluded with the Brampton North Youth Council presented her with their Pre-Budget Submission, including their budget asks for the government.
