KEEPING OUR SCHOOLS HEALTHY

Keeping both our children and environment healthy has always been a priority for our Government. That is why we're investing to upgrade 162 Ontario schools to become more energy efficient and support better indoor air quality.

Ensuring our schools

have proper ventilation systems is crucial to student health and we are excited to announce that we've given Peel District School Board over \$2.5 million to upgrade our schools, with part of that funding going to North Park Secondary School right here in Brampton.



INVESTING IN A GREENER BRAMPTON

We're electrifying Brampton Transit! Our city is part of an exciting project where for the first time ever, electric vehicles and electric chargers from different manufacturers can all be used interchangeably. This breakthrough in electric bus technology will help us reduce pollution, keep our air cleaner, and add more buses to our transit system.

Brampton Transit is receiving eight electric buses to add to our already impressive fleet- try one out on Route 23 or Route 26!



New Pathways For Brampton



We're helping Brampton get out and be active by investing to build new and expanded networks of pathways, bike lanes, trails, and pedestrian bridges.

This is the first federal fund dedicated to building active transportation throughout Canada and is part of our plan to create one million jobs, fight climate change, and help Canadians move through their cities.

This summer, pull out your bikes and enjoy all the trails and paths Brampton and the broader GTA have to offer!

Historic New Investment in Brampton Transit

To keep Brampton moving, we're funding the construction of a new public transit maintenance and storage facility for our city's bus fleet. This new project is the largest ever federal investment in Brampton East, coming in at over \$45.3 million.

This funding will help to build our largest transit facility and create more than 850 well-paying jobs in Brampton during construction and 1000 jobs when the facility is up and running. With this new facility, Brampton's public transit will improve its capacity, quality, and safety.









BUILDING BRAMPTON



Investing in our arts and culture hubs enriches our cities and promotes the cultural diversity that makes Brampton unique.

To support Brampton arts, we're proud to announce federal funding to rehabilitate The Rose, one of our most beloved performing arts theatres.

We're providing more than \$2.2 million to fund various accessibility upgrades, seating replacements, emergency alarm upgrades, adding a wheelchair lift, and other important infrastructure improvements.

New Youth Hub In The Sportsplex

We're investing \$565,000 to create a new Youth Hub within the South Fletcher's Sportsplex. This project will provide our youth with a safe and accessible space to do their schoolwork, participate in community programs, and be given access to several resources and services.

Investing in our youth will always be a priority for our Government. We're thrilled to be providing a space for our young people to gather in and connect with one another to help build stronger communities in Brampton.



We're Renovating the Chingcousy Wellness Centre

Investing in recreation centres promotes people's health and well-being and builds inclusive and sustainable communities where people want to live, work and raise families.

We're investing \$572, 000 to renovate the Chingcousy Wellness Centre. These renovations include interior and exterior renovations that are set to improve overall accessibility and include new amenities like a sauna, changerooms, shower facilities, new washrooms, and more!





SUPPORTING BRAMPTON FAMILIES

Buying your first home is an important milestone for many families, that's why we've expanded the First Time Home Buyer's Incentive for residents living in the GTA.

If you're eligible, you can now use this incentive to purchase properties worth up to \$722,000.

We're building affordable housing right here in Brampton! We're helping fund the construction of the Brampton Bramalea Christian Fellowship Residences, a 6-storey building with 89 affordable housing units that will be geared to low-income families, seniors, and individuals with disabilities.

When we launched our Rapid Housing Initiative last year, we had a goal of building 3000 new affordable housing units for Canadians. But with Budget 2021, we're investing an additional \$1.5 billion to build a total of 9,2000 units all across Canada. Every Canadian deserves safe and affordable housing and we're delivering on this goal.



We're Supporting Women's Shelters



Combatting gender based violence has always been a priority for our Government. That is why we are funding women's shelters and sexual assault centres right here in Brampton.

Honeychurch Family Life Resource Centre, Hope 24/7, and Sakeenah Homes are all organizations in Brampton doing important and lifechanging work. We are proud to be supporting them in their missions to support the people who need it most.
