With Parliament adjourned for the summer, I will be focusing on engaging with my constituents on the issues that matter most. Since the beginning of the session in September 2020, our Government has invested in projects that are vital to Brampton including housing, senior care, the environment, small business supports, and most importantly, helping Canadians through the COVID-19 pandemic. Here are some the achievements I'm most proud of:



- We procured the most diverse vaccine portfolio in the world, ordering hundreds of millions of vaccines to fully vaccinate every Canadian who wants to be by September
- Thanks to our procurement strategy, as of July 5, over 78% of eligible Canadians have their first dose! And more than 37% are fully vaccinated!
- We also launched the Made in Canada plan to increase domestic PPE manufacturing, including right here in the GTA

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- We provided two one-time payments to OAS recipients to support seniors during the pandemic
- We're increasing OAS by 10% for all seniors aged 75 and older
- We increased the Basic Personal Amount to benefit 4.3 million seniors
- We created the Age Well At Home program and expanded the New Horizons for Seniors program to help seniors live well at home
- We also invested \$3 billion to support long-term care homes and create national standards to ensure all seniors are treated with respect and dignity



Supporting Our Seniors



- Invested to create 9,200 new affordable housing units through the Rapid Housing Initiative
- Expanded the Affordable Housing Innovation Fund to build an additional 12,700 units
- Increased funding to the National Housing Co-Investment Fund to build 3,400 new units

Investing In Housing



- Passed Bill C-12, which will hold the federal government to its commitment to achieve net-zero emissions by 2050
- Committed to and began planting 2 billion trees
- Banned single use plastics and committed to fighting plastic pollution
- Launched the Canada Greener Homes Grant to help Canadians upgrade their homes to be more energy efficient
- Invested in making electric vehicles more affordable and accessible in Canada

Protecting Our Environment



- We lifted 108 long-term water advisories as of June 16, 2021
- We have implemented several of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls To Action and are committed to implementing even more
- Announced the Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women and Girls National Action Plan

Advancing Indigenous Reconciliation



- Expanded the Canadian Race Relations Foundation to help tackle racism, including creating a national coalition to support Asian Canadian communities
- Funded 85 projects through the Anti-Racism Action Program
- Increased our support to the Black Entrepreneurship Fund
- Created the Black Philanthropic Endowment Fund, which will support Black-led charities and organizations
